Old Business—

Booster Funding Requests- Funding request form updated with new officers names.

Bowling Plaque-Laura Norman suggested a smaller version of the trophy that the school received be placed at the bowling center. She will check with Paul Abromaitis to see if he has a place to put it.

Extra Fence Tubing-Laura Norman updated us on possible locations to use the tubing we have; the football field, soccer field entrance, etc. There was a discussion about purchasing more tubing to give a more finished look. We will discuss at the August meeting.

Cross Country Board-No update at this time.

New Business—

Cross Country Uniform Request-Sheri Vallad presented a funding request from the Varsity Cross Country coach-Kory Lohrmann for new uniforms (a total of 30) in the amount of \$594.50 (1/3 of the cost). They currently use the Varsity Track uniforms. The school is providing 1/3 and the team has done fundraising to raise the last 1/3. They currently have \$588.87 in the team account. After some discussion, a motion to approve \$594.50 for cross country team uniforms was made by Stacey Abromaitis and seconded by Laura Norman. All in favor.

Pink Out Event-Jim Honnold presented his plan to hold a community wide Pink Out Week. This year's event will be held the week of September 11. He wanted to make the boosters aware of his progress so far. He has held one meeting with the committee he has formed for this event and will have the next one on July 12. He stated that it will be a continuation of the Love Like Lori event that was held last fall and will benefit families in our community who are dealing with cancer. He would like to see all teams wearing pink starting with the football jerseys. He will be asking the boosters to make a donation in the near future. Sheri Vallad stated that if he wants a donation to buy jerseys, he would need two quotes. He stated that he wants to keep everything local including the Crafty Vine in Dryden to purchase all shirts and jerseys.

Snack Shack-Sheri Vallad presented information/prices to paint the snack shack floor with an epoxy paint –red, black, white fleck color. After some discussion regarding amount needed, a motion was made by Laura Norman to approve up to \$250.00 to paint the snack shack floor. Seconded by Stacy Abromaitis. All in favor. Shawna Penn and Sheri Vallad will be doing a deep cleaning in the building then doing the painting this summer.

Other New Business-

Banner Ads-Laura Norman stated Deanna DeVlaminck has been unable to get an answer regarding any price increase for new banner ads. She wanted to update the info for banner ads before she solicits for new ones.

Mr. Zauner mentioned that he and Jennifer Cronkright are working on getting a physician in to do sports physicals along with heart checks at the school. The tentative date is August 3rd.
